

SCHEDULE OF FEES - ATC Professional™

Licensing - Seat Basis

ATC Professional™ software is licensed according to the number of seats (computers/work stations) that are required at a given SITE. A SITE is defined as any specific business location that has its own physical mailing address. Thus, for example, a Refinery or Chemical Plant is considered a SITE even though it may encompass multiple office buildings.

The minimum licensing requirement for the ATC Professional™ product is one (1) SITE license and one (1) SEAT license. NOTE: *Only Planners/Schedulers need a Seat License; all others may have unlimited access to ATC Professional™ in order to enter/create work orders, view and print reports, etc.*

A SITE license for may be ATC Professional™ may be acquired for a one-time fee of USD 4,500.-

SEAT licenses for ATC Professional™ may be acquired for a one-time fee of USD 500.- each

The total MINIMUM licensing fees for acquiring one (1) initial seat of ATC Professional™ is a one-time fee of USD 5,000.- (Five Thousand US Dollars), plus Maintenance and Support fees (see below) which add ten percent (10%) for a grand total of \$ 5,500.-

Licensing - Enterprise Basis

Corporate-wide (Enterprise) licenses are available for unlimited access for all corporate sites. No registration of individual workstations is required. Please request a proposal for Enterprise licensing tailored to your organization.

Maintenance and Support Fees

Yearly Maintenance and Support fees are ten percent (10%) of the total licensing fees, and are payable in advance, at initial licensing time.

Maintenance and Support includes unlimited technical assistance via toll-free telephone (within the U.S.A.), telephone, e-mail and fax, and access to our online update download repository at our web page. Inclusion to the beneficiary list for the escrowed source code is available for an initial set-up fee of \$ 1,000.- plus a yearly maintenance fee of \$ 500.- payable in advance.

Shipping

After receipt of your Purchase Order, we can ship ATC Professional™ via courier (FedEx, DHL, UPS, etc.) to anywhere in the world. Shipping will be billed at cost. Immediate electronic delivery (via e-mail) is also available at no cost.

Consulting / Training

Consulting and/or training can be scheduled for U\$D 760 for the first eight (8) hours, then U\$D 95 for every additional hour. A minimum of eight hours a day will be billed for work days, even if less hours are actually worked. On long term assignments. Consultants get to travel home for at least one weekend per month. Standby time will be billed at a flat rate of U\$D 500 for every holiday or non-working day, except normal weekends.

Travel-Related Expenses

Travel expenses (air fare, car rental, airport exit taxes, etc.) are billed at cost plus a ten percent (10%) handling fee. A flat Per Diem amount will be charged, in lieu of reimbursing itemized expenses, sufficient to cover the costs for hotels, meals, laundry and incidentals. Per diem will be billed seven (7) days a week, during the stay of the Consultant. Travel time will be billed at a flat rate of U\$D 500 per day of travel.

Invoicing / Payments

Invoices are due and payable upon receipt of the software products. A monthly service fee of 1.5% will apply on any invoices that become past due after thirty (30) days. Invoices must be paid in full in U.S. Dollars.

Fees to Cover EFT Bank Charges

A service fee of U\$D 95.- will be charged to cover bank processing fees for all payments made via Electronic Funds Transfers (EFTs). Request instructions for making payments via EFT.
